**BY-LAW No.903-22**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OYEN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REPEAL BYLAW 377.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal a bylaw; and

**WHEREAS**, Council deems it appropriate to repeal certain obsolete and superseded bylaws of the Town of Oyen;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of Town of Oyen assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known as "Repeal Bylaw 377 Bylaw".

THAT Bylaw 377 being the curfew bylaw be repealed as it is no longer deemed necessary to Town operations.


2. THAT the repeal date of the above Bylaw be the date of final passage of this Bylaw.
3. THAT this bylaw shall continue in full force and effect in perpetuity.


Read a first time this 13th day of September, 2022.

Read a second time this 9th day of September, 2022.

Given unanimous consent to proceed to third and final reading this 13th day of September, 2022.

Read a third time and finally passed this 13th day of September, 2022.
