

**TOWN OF OYEN
ADVERTISING BYLAW 874-20**

**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH ALTERNATIVE METHODS FOR ADVERTISING STATUTORY
NOTICES**

WHEREAS

pursuant to section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act*, a council must give notice of certain bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings or other things by advertising in a newspaper or other publication circulating in the area, mailing or delivering a notice to every residence in the affected area or by another method provided for in a bylaw under section

and WHEREAS

pursuant to section 606.1(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, a council may, by bylaw, provide for one or more methods, which may include electronic means, for advertising proposed bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings and other things referred to in section 606;

and WHEREAS

Council is satisfied that the advertising method set out in this Bylaw is likely to bring matters advertised by that method to the attention of substantially all residents in the area to which the bylaw, resolution or other thing relates or in which the meeting or hearing is to be held;

THEREFORE**

**THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OYEN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY
ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Short Title

This Bylaw may be referred to as the "Advertising Bylaw".

**2. Advertising
Method**

Any notice required to be advertised under section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act* of a bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing or other thing may be given, in accordance with the timelines prescribed in section 606,

- published in a local weekly newspaper

and/or

- electronically by posting the notice prominently on the Town of Oyen's official website

and/or

- electronically by posting the notice prominently on any of the Town of Oyen's official social media sites

and/or


- by posting the notice prominently on bulletin boards provided for that purpose in the following Town of Oyen municipal facilities: Administrative Office, Arena, and Pool.

and/or


- electronically by posting the notice prominently on local media outlets' official websites and/or social sites.

3. Severability

If any Section or parts of this bylaw are found in any court of law to be illegal or beyond the power of Council to enact, such Section or parts shall be deemed severable and all other Sections or parts of this bylaw shall be deemed to be separate and independent from and to be enacted as such.








