

**BY-LAW NO. 740-01  
OF THE TOWN OF OYEN  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

A By-Law to authorize the Council of the Town of Oyen  
to appoint an Assessor as a Designated Officer.

**WHEREAS** Section 284 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 1994, and amendments thereto requires that an Assessor be appointed as a Designated Officer.

**AND WHEREAS** Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1994, outlines the appointment of Designated Officers;


**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Oyen, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:


1. That the Municipal Assessor be appointed annually, at a regular meeting of the Municipality.
2. That the Municipal Assessor be a qualified assessor in the Province of Alberta.
3. That the Municipal Assessor is hereby appointed as a Designated Officer of the Town of Oyen for that purpose.
4. That the Municipal Assessor, carry out the duties of the Assessor as outlined under Parts 9, 10, 11 and 12 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 1994.
5. The Municipal Assessor, and/or his employees, be deemed to be an Independent Contractor and not an employee of the Town of Oyen.
6. That this By-Law shall become effective upon the date of the passing of the Third and Final Reading of this By-Law.
