## BY-LAW NO. 740-01 OF THE TOWN OF OYEN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A By-Law to authorize the Council of the Town of Oyen to appoint an Assessor as a Designated Officer.

WHEREAS Section 284 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 1994, and amendments thereto requires that an Assessor be appointed as a Designated Officer.

AND WHEREAS Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1994, outlines the appointment of Designated Officers;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Oyen, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Municipal Assessor be appointed annually, at a regular meeting of the Municipality.
- 2. That the Municipal Assessor be a qualified assessor in the Province of Alberta.
- 3. That the Municipal Assessor is hereby appointed as a Designated Officer of the Town of Oyen for that purpose.
- 4. That the Municipal Assessor, carry out the duties of the Assessor as outlined under Parts 9, 10, 11 and 12 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 1994.
- 5. The Municipal Assessor, and/or his employees, be deemed to be an Independent Contractor and not an employee of the Town of Oyen.
- 6. That this By-Law shall become effective upon the date of the passing of the Third and Final Reading of this By-Law.
