## TOWN OF OYEN BYLAW NUMBER # 805-11

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OYEN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER FOR THE TOWN OF OYEN.

WHEREAS Section 205(1) of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, that every Council must establish by bylaw a position of chief administrative officer; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Oyen, desire to establish the position of chief administrative officer.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Oyen, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The position of chief administrative officer for the Town of Oyen is hereby established.
- 2. The title of the chief administrative officer for Town of Oyen shall be "Chief Administrative Officer".
- 3. That Bylaw No. 582 is hereby rescinded.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of final reading hereof.
